



### **Student researcher workshop 3**

- ~60 minutes – depending on the number of students that attend
- Re-do introductions

#### **The process of gathering peer feedback:**

- When / how / from whom / on what have they gathered peer feedback?
- How was it captured / recorded?
- How easy did they find it second time around?

#### **What they have found:**

- Ask students to feedback what they have found so far, to sum it up.
- Working as one group or by year group or in pairs ask students to compile the results into one document - i.e. as a PowerPoint, a short report in the style of a blog / newspaper article / news report on the radio / tweet etc etc addressing the key questions.

#### **Reflections:**

- What challenges have they faced gathering the feedback and how have these been addressed?
- What, if anything, have they learnt about themselves from taking part in the Student Panels?
- What new skills have they gained?
- How are they working as a team, if not why not?
- What, if anything, did they do differently this time compared to the first time?
- How has the identity of the group worked for / helped them?

#### **Next steps:**

- What, if anything, would they like to recap on?
- Activities to focus gathering feedback on before final visit.
- Collating the feedback – either in advance or on the day.
- Anything particular they would like to see at the university at the final event?
