

Student researcher final feedback session

> ~60 minutes – depending how chatty the students are.

In 2s or 3s take 5 minutes to discuss the following:

- 1. How did you find the process of gathering peer feedback?
 - When / how / from whom did you gathered peer feedback?
 - How did you capture and record your feedback?
 - What was the most effective way?
- 2. What, if any, challenges or difficulties have you faced when gathering the feedback and how were these resolved?
- 3. What more could we have done to prepare you for the task of gathering peer feedback?
- 4. How well supported have you felt by your teacher(s)?
- 5. What other support or preparation would you have liked?
- 6. What could we do differently when setting up similar groups in the future? (Any advice for us to help the group succeed?)

Open general discussion:

- 1. What, if anything, have you learnt about <u>vourself</u> from taking part in the Student Research group?
- 2. What <u>new skills</u> have you gained? (i.e., teamwork, confidence, notetaking, analytical skills, etc)
- 3. How useful or not was the group identity / name?
- 4. Overall, how have you felt about being part of the group?
 - a. Would you be more or less likely to volunteer to do something similar in the future?
 - b. Would you encourage other students to be part of something similar?
 - c. How would you encourage other students to take part?
