Using the feedback you have gathered throughout the year on the different raising aspirations activities compile a short presentation (10-15 minutes or 500 words) in whatever format you like (i.e. a blog, tweet, news report, PowerPoint etc) to answer the following questions:

- 1. How have the activities helped you and your fellow students:
 - a. To improve knowledge and awareness of the benefits of higher education and graduate employment?
 - b. To better understand the options available to after leaving school/college?
 - c. With the confidence to make decisions about the future?
 - d. To develop the skills (i.e. revisions and exam techniques, teamwork etc) needed to succeed in the future?
 - e. Better understand how subjects at school and college are linked to careers you/they may be interested in?
- 2. How could the activities be improved? What would make them more effective and memorable?
- 3. Overall, what difference have the activities made to you and your fellow students especially in terms of planning your future career paths?
- 4. How would you explain your role to other students?
- 5. How would you teach another student how to do this role?
